



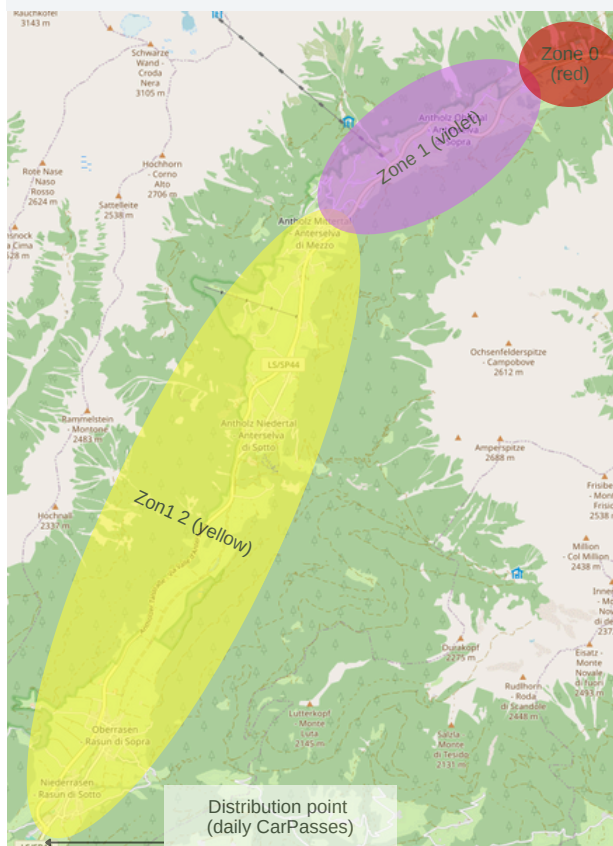
Traffic regulations Olympic Winter Games in the Antholz Valley

CarPass during the 2026 biathlon competitions

For access to the Antholz Valley during the competition days (10 days), a 3-zone system will apply, in which a separate car pass is required for entry into each zone. From October 2025, car passes will be available through the Milano Cortina online portal. The car passes must then be collected physically, as they are stickers for car windshields. Information about where and how to pick them up will be provided later.

There will be different types of passes, for example for local residents, businesses, commuters, and guests. This way, everyone can get the pass that fits their needs.

In addition, a pass distribution point will be set up at the entrance to the valley, where day passes can be issued directly on site if needed.



Zone 0 – Red (Biathlon Centre)

Access only with special authorization (VAPP). This regulation applies from 07.01.2026. Access to Lake Anterselva and the Staller Saddle remains possible on foot, but under specific conditions.

Zone 1 – Violet (Antholz Mitteltal to Antholz Obertal)

To access this area, a Car Pass is required from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Inside the area, free circulation is permitted without a pass. No pass is required to exit.

Zone 2 – Yellow (Niederrassen to Antholz Mitteltal)

To access this area, a Car Pass is required from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Inside the area, free circulation is permitted without a pass. No pass is required to exit.
